2020 SUMMER CAMP TAHOSA HIGH ADVENTURE BASE

Planning and preparing for our 2020 camping season is underway. To ensure proper planning for continued quality programs and a super camping experience, the following payment schedule is required. Your continued cooperation in meeting the payment schedule is appreciated. Communication is one of the key elements of camp. If your unit has any concerns or opportunities, please let us know; we are here for you. You can reach the Camping Department at 720-266-2111 or camping@denverboyscouts.org.

*Tahosa Trek combined with EaglePoint is an introduction to backpacking for both Scouts and Scouters. It is a hybrid between EaglePoint and Alpine Adventure. You will spend 2 days at working on merit badges and 2 1/2 days backpacking. This does not replace the week-long EaglePoint summer camp program. Tahosa Trek is limited to 11 participants includes one adult leader and Trek Guide.

FEE PAYMENT SCHEDULE:

Beginning with the 2020 we will have a reduced rate for the first 2, 3, or 4 leaders depending on the number of Scouts you bring to camp

*2019 summer camp fees will be valid if your troop signs up by August 31, 2019. This includes the first 2 adults being free.

EaglePoint Troops - \$349 per Scout

Tahosa Trek Troops - \$399 per Scout/\$50 Adult Fee

Unit Deposit - \$100.00 non-refundable deposit due at time of sign up to hold your summer camp reservation. Fee will be credited to your 2020 summer camp fees.

November 4, 2019 - \$50.00 (non-refundable) deposit per camper for number of Scouts listed. **February 3, 2020**, additional payment of \$100.00 per camper for the registered number of Scouts is due. **April 6, 2020**, additional \$100.00 per camper for the registered number of Scouts is due. **May 4, 2020**, outstanding balance for each camper and adult is due.

EaglePoint Adult fees:

1-19 Scouts – 2 adult leaders \$175, \$225 for each additional adult 20-39 Scouts – 3 adult leaders \$175, \$225 for each additional adult 40+ Scouts – 4 adult leaders \$175, \$225 for each additional adult

The adult leaders that are eligible for the reduced rate, can have their registration cost reduced by \$100 by going through a fingerprinting background check for the FBI, CBI, and Trails Abuse/Neglect. The background check is good for 5 years. Denver Area Council will pay for your background check, so the \$100 reduced rate will not be applied until the second year.

Example, if a leader does the background check for 2020, their cost for 2020 will be \$175 but for years 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2024 will be \$75.

More information on how to submit background checks will be published in the fall of 2020.

REFUNDS/CANCELLATIONS:

Scouts cancelled before May 6, 2020 will be refunded full amount less \$50 non-refundable deposit.

After deadline - No fees will be refunded unless documented by a medical doctor or a death in the family. Scoutmaster or Camp Contact Person should request all refunds.

The \$50 per Scout deposit is non-refundable at any time but may be applied to other troop members as long as the unit's total registration count does not go down.

"No Show" Scouts. If you have "No Show" Scouts at your 2020 summer camp check in, causing your overall number to decrease from pre-registration number, your unit may be subject to a \$100 per "No Show" Scout fee in addition to the full camp fee.

Refunds while attending camp. If a Scout or participant becomes ill or has an injury while attending camp and is sent home prior to Wednesday by order of the camp medical director, the Scout will receive a 50% refund of fees paid. If a Scout or participant goes home after Wednesday, they WILL NOT receive any type of refund (camp and program fees). Scouts or participants who leave camp for behavioral issues, by their own choice, or for any other reason, WILL NOT receive a refund (camp or program fees).
